Updates from our AGM 2024/25

The PTA's Annual General Meeting took place on Friday 10th October, a great opportunity to review the past year.

Mr Askew thanked the PTA and parents for a successful year of fundraising, which resulted in a significant increase in money, almost £5k, being available to support school projects such as:

£2,500 for improvements to the Science Block which was matched by Greenham Trust. £1,400 awarded through Pitch to the PTA to various items requested by students from each year group. Then further support was provided:

£454 Primary School Garden equipment

£393 Nintendo Switch

£100 Prize Giving awards

£119 Mulled Wine for staff at Christmas

There was also time to discuss the coming year, with some exciting funding opportunities being identified, including:

- A 2026 Pitch to the PTA in January next year to again involve students in developing enrichment projects and ideas
- Items for the Youth Club relaunch
- End of Year extravaganza activities and workshops
