## 100 CLUB The November Draw

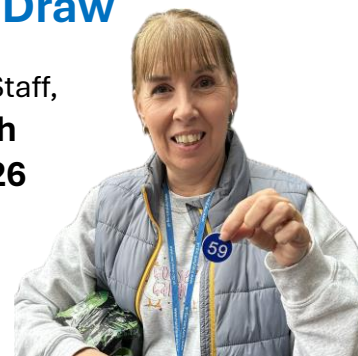
