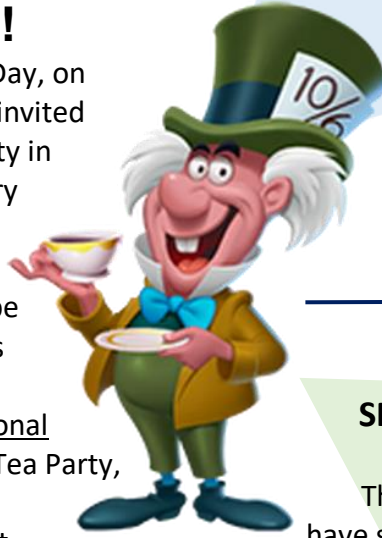

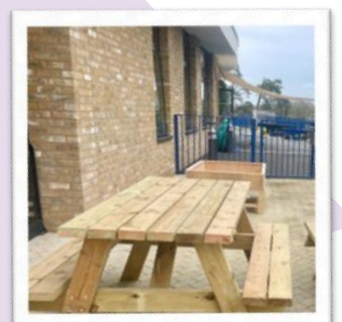
Calling all Pre-Loved Uniform
