TELLONYM lets you "answer anonymous questions and ask others the things you have never dared before.". User profiles contain one photo (though many more can be seen by linking the app to Snapchat, Twitter, and Instagram), and users can follow each other and send each other anonymous messages.

Due to the anonymous nature of the app you can communicate with people you do not know and there is a high potential for cyberbullying and unkind messaging.
